FIRST PHASE AT HOBE SOUND SOLD OUT

at South Florida's newest polo community, the first phase of the new polo club had now been sold out.

"We were delighted to have so much interest in the Hobe Sound Polo Club in the past few days," said Robert Whitley – who in partnership with Tucker Frederickson and Rockwood Capital Corporation is the developer of Hobe Sound Polo Club. "Although we were not expecting to sell out so quickly, it is obvious that the location, quality and value of the Club have been immediately recognized by the polo community. Our interaction with the polo world has been most enjoyable and it is thanks to the enthusiasm and commitment from the three founders of the Hobe Sound Polo Club; Ted Brinkmann, Merle Jenkins and Andres Weisz, that the Club has made such an impact on polo players – both amateur and professional."

The developer Robert Whitley is nationally recognized for his expertise in the development of upscale

golf course communities including several such projects carried out in conjunction with the great golfer and golf designer Jack Nicklaus. Their latest project, the Bear's Club, is located in the vicinity of Hobe Sound and was selected by Travel and Leisure Golf as the #2 Golf Course Community in the US.

Last week Hobe Sound Polo Club became associated with a great polo player of its own, when Adolfo Cambiaso was welcome as its newest member. Cambiaso purchased at the club in partnership with Andres Weisz and announced plans to build a private field and barn to set up a horse operation aside from his high goal polo-playing commitments, which will remain in Wellington at the International Polo Club Palm Beach.

"It is obviously a great asset for the club to have a player with Adolfo Cambiaso's reputation on board as one of our initial members," said Whitley. "We have now sold 26

lots, which closes out the first phase of the development. In addition to Adolfo, the club has a wide range of polo players from amateur to professional, who have decided to make Hobe Sound Polo Club their home or base for polo operations in Florida." Whitley also noted that several purchasers have opted to combine multiple lots to create their own significant polo-oriented compounds within the community.

We've been told that due to the early sell out of the initial phase, Hobe Sound Polo Club has announced that it is now taking reservations for the second phase of development.

The Hobe Sound Polo Club is located seven miles from the beach inland from Jupiter Island, 20 minutes from Palm Beach International airport and 30 minutes from Wellington; and 10 minutes from the Palm Beach Gardens Mall. The community offers 20-acre parcels.

The club will have five competition fields, two stick and ball fields and a track as well as a clubhouse and extensive interlocking trails throughout the community, which adjoins over 8,000 acres in the Atlantic Ridge State Park providing additional recreational riding for members to enjoy.
